4. Allen, Harrison. **On a new method of recording the motions of the soft palate**. Philadelphia: P. Blakiston, Son & Co., 1884.

Condition: good, though slightly loose at the spine.

5. Alt, Ferdinand. **Die Taubheit infolge von meningitis cerebrospinalis epidemica**. Leipzig and Vienna: Franz Deuticke, 1908.

Condition: paper reprint lightly acidified with weak spine.

8. Arlt, Ferdinand, Ritter von. **Die Krankheiten des Auges**. 3 vols. Prague: F. A. Credner & Kleinbub, 1855-56.

Condition: 1 copy of vol. 1; 2 copies of vol. 3. All copies have acidified pages; worn leather spines; tortoise-shell patterned boards.

16. Bing, Albert. **Vorlesungen uber ohrenheilkunde**. Vienna: Braumuller, 1890.

Condition: fair. Has been treated for red rot.

22. Buchan, G. **Medicine domestique ou traite complet des moyens de se conserver en sante ...** Paris: Moutardier, 1802. Fifth edition. Two volumes (Vol. 1; Vol. 3) of a five volume set, a French translation by J. D. Duplanil of William Buchan's British text. The use of the letter "G" in the name of the author has not been explained; a fourth edition, also French, was listed in Bookman's Price Index for 1979 under the name "William Buchan" and dated 1789.

Condition: Poor. The exterior of Vol. 1 is deteriorated by red rot but internally fine. The exterior of Vol. 3 is worn and the boards are loose; again it is internally fine.

24. Carmalt, Churchill; Schulte, H. von W. **Studies in cancer and allied subjects: Volume 4; Contributions to the anatomy and development of the salivary glands in the mammalia**. New York: Columbia University Press, 1913. Conducted under the George Crocker special research fund at Columbia University.

Condition: worn, but good. Original board covers, text in good shape. Oversized.

31. Coulson, William; Coulson, Walter. **Coulson on diseases of the bladder**. 6th edition with revisions by Walter Coulson. New York: William Wood & Company, 1881. 2 copies available.

Condition: Both lightly acidified with cracked spine at top and bottom. Otherwise good.

34. Cunningham, D. J; Brash, James Couper; Jamison, E. B. **Cunningham's textbook of anatomy**. New York: Oxford University Press, 1937.

Condition: good.

38. Cutler, Elliot; Robert Zollinger. **Atlas of Surgical Operations**. New York: MacMillan, 1953.

Condition: paperback volume with front cover missing and several loose pages.

Condition: excellent.

Condition: Two copies available, both in very good condition.

Condition: Cover, spine and corners all deteriorated, but the book block holds firm in good condition.

Condition: good.

Condition: excellent aside from light acidification.

Condition: original bindings surprisingly good; of the five volumes only one displays a spine separating from its front cover. All edges show wear. Little foxing or staining of the texts.
111. Munk, William. **Roll of the Royal College of Physicians of London.** Volume I - 1518-1700; Volume II - 1701-1800; Volume III - 1801-1825. Second edition. London, Royal College of Physicians, 1975.
Condition: Incomplete; missing Volumes IV-VI, 1826-1975. Bindings and text blocks good.
112. Munter, Seussman; Fred Rosner, editors. **Selected medical writings of Moses Maimonides.** New York: Classics of Medicine Library, division of Gryphon Editions, 1997.
Condition: excellent.

114. Nothnagel, Hermann, editor. **Specielle pathologie und therapie** (series title). Vienna, Alfred Holder, 1896-1911. Series incomplete; includes volumes 2, 3, 5, 7, 8, 12, 13, 14, 16, 19.
Condition: Original bindings on all volumes, stamped in gold, but all are worn. Several have been treated for red rot and several are lacking a spine. The series contains reprints of important authors such as Paul Ehrlich on anemia and leukemia; Hermann Lenhartz on erysipelas; and Otto Binswanger on epilepsy.

121. Pavy, Frederick W. **Treatise on food and dietetics physiologically and therapeutically considered**. Second edition. Series: Wood's Library of Standard Medical Authors. New York: William Wood & Company, 1881.
Condition: good.

124. Predohl, August. **Die Geschichte der Tuberkulose**. Hamburg und Leipzig: Leopold Voss, 1888.
Condition: paperback volume with cover torn from library tape spine. Pages lightly acidified.

125. **Professional anecdotes or ana of medical literature**. London: John Knight & Henry Lacey, 1825. Volumes I and III of three. Volume I contains facsimile correspondence presented as original.
Condition: good. Both have been rebound with library bindings. There are engraved title pages and plates of great charm in each.

130. Roemer, Paul. Matthias Foster, translator. **Textbook of ophthalmology in the form of clinical lectures**. Volume 1 only. New York, Rebman Company, 1913.
Condition: good. Pages lightly acidified. Excellent color illustrations.

131. Rohlf's, Heinrich. **Geschichte der deutschen Medicin: die medicinischen Classiker Deutschlands**. Stuttgart: F. Enke, 1875-1880, 2 vol.
Condition: poor. Dry and chipping pages, loose pages. Vol. 1 is missing its spine, and the boards are consequently loose.

132. Rokitansky, Karl. **Lehrbuch der pathologischen Anatomie**. Vol. 1 of 3. Vienna: Braumuller, 1855.
Condition: fair. Front and back boards and leather spine cover loosened from spine. Text excellent.

135. Routh, Charles H. F. **Infant feeding and its influence on life: or the causes and prevention of infant mortality**. 3rd edition. Series: Wood's Library of Standard Medical Authors. New York: William Wood & Company, 1879.
Condition: text in good shape. Original binding good although cracked along the front edge of spine.

136. Russell Sage Foundation and National Tuberculosis Association, with Phillip Jacob, compiler. **Campaign against tuberculosis in the United States, including a directory of institutions dealing with tuberculosis in the United States and Canada**. New York: Charities Publication Committee, 1908.
Condition: excellent.

Condition: fair. Book block fine but original covers are worn and loose.

Condition: good. Oversized.

166. Wilson, James C. **Treatise on the continued fevers.** New York: William Wood & Co., 1881. Series: Wood's Library of Standard Medical Authors.

Condition: 2 copies, both in original covers. Spine split at top and bottom of each. One copy has split book block. Both lightly acidified.

Condition: poor. Original covers but no spine cover. Book block separated from covers with some loose pages.

Condition: fair. Text block good, but covers are dry and cracked along the spine, and text is separating along the front.
