Dear Sir

I have delayed replying to your letter of June 30 because I have been hoping ^{see this to go} into the Laboratory to attempt something with the Gastric Fluid. I can only say that hitherto I have found it impossible owing to mesany & inevitable demands on my time. I write now merely that
