

School of Nursing Graduates 83 on 75th Anniversary

"The actions of a single nurse are worth more than all the actions of the United Nations," Dr. Joel Lester Zeffren said to the School of Nursing's 75th graduating class in their ceremonies on Jan. 28th. Zeffren told the 83 graduates that they have the power and ability to promote peace in the world. "You must rise against inadequacies and all prejudices," he said, "and in that way you can set an example for all society."

It was the fourth year Dr. Zeffren was chosen to address the graduating nurses. He spoke of the need not only to deliver health care smoothly, but to minister to the emotional needs of today's deindividualized patient. There needs to be a "liberation of individuals," he said, and "it is this liberation that is the task of nurses today."

"You have to do it with human beings who

are willing to give of themselves," Zeffren said. Nurses must communicate, "I'm here, I care. I will serve you."

Raymond H. Wittcoff, Chairman of the Board of Directors, and Martin Bergmann, M.D., immediate past president of the Medical Staff Association, greeted the graduating nurses and their family and friends. Susan Graves, Director of the School of Nursing, presented pins and David A. Gee, Hospital President, handed out diplomas.


Of the 83 graduates, 51 are remaining at the hospital as employees, a tribute to the outstanding nursing program here.

Auxiliary President Helene Goldstein presents the Auxiliary Award to Rebecca Lichterman, the highest ranking student in the graduating class.



Pilgrimage Honors William Beaumont, M.D.

A brisk, fall morning was the scene of the Beaumont Pilgrimage, held November 20, 1978, at Bellefontaine Cemetary.

The Pilgrimage to the grave of William Beaumont (1785-1853), is conducted annually by the St. Louis Medical Society. The event honors Dr. Beaumont, one of the founding members of the Medical Society.

The program also memorialized the 22 members of the Medical Society who have passed away since November, 1977.

Following a recital by the Beaumont High School Choir, Beaumont Memorial Committee Chairman Samuel D. Soule, M.D., introduced Jewish Hospital President David A. Gee.

The Pilgrimage guest speaker, Gee told the gathering, "It is a privilege for me to present remarks on the 45th Annual Memorial Service and the 193rd anniversary of the birth of

Dr. William Beaumont, pioneer physician and surgeon, gastric physiologist and St. Louis Medical Society Member."

Mr. Gee explained that through genealogical study, he learned of his own relationship to Dr. Beaumont. In 1879, Gee's great grandfather, Charles Sackett Gilbert, married Mary Eunice Beaumont, William Beaumont's niece.

Memory of Beaumont Lives On

"In 1912," Gee said, "Jesse Myer, M.D., a member of the Jewish Hospital Medical Staff and Dr. Beaumont's biographer, wrote: 'Few are the pilgrimages to the grave and few there are who even know where lie the remains of this unique and remarkable man. Yet all mankind has profited by virtue of his having lived and worked."

According to Gee, Dr. Myer died shortly thereafter, and, ironically was unaware of the tradition of the Beaumont Pilgrimages, which began in 1923, and are still held today.

Jewish Hospital Welcomes New Board Chairman

In January, 1974, the Board of Directors of Jewish Hospital elected Lee M. Liberman as Chairman. At the beginning of this year, Liberman completed his five one year terms of office and was succeeded by Raymond M. Wittcoff.

During the five years that Liberman was Chairman of the Board, the Hospital celebrated several landmark occasions. In August, 1974, the Shoenberg Pavilion was dedicated. In 1975, the Hospital celebrated its 75th anniversary. The period also saw the attainment of five new Chiefs of Service.

The past five years have been progressive ones for Jewish Hospital. Recently Mr. Liberman commented on the highlights of his term.

Superior Administration, Supervision

Lee M. Liberman graduated from Yale University with a degree in Chemical Engineering. He joined Laclede Gas Company as an engineer in 1945, and was named President in 1970. In January, 1974, he assumed the duties of President of The Jewish Hospital of St. Louis.

"I'm the only person that has ever been both President of the Hospital and Chairman of the Board, because early in my term, we decided that the appropriate designation was to have me as Chairman and David Gee as President," Liberman said. "I think David Gee is unequaled as a Hospital Director. Any successful administrator has to have a lot of excellent people working for him, and I think we have excellent people from first-line supervisors all the way up to Mr. Gee. The Hospital also has a dedicated staff of employees. The Auxiliary and Associates in Medicine also serve important functions. Our Voluntary staff and Full-time staff of doctors and other professionals are of the highest degree of competence so that excellent professional care is a certainty. All of this bodes well for the future of the Hospital."

Solidified Leadership Achieved

Looking back over his five years as Chair-

man of the Board, Liberman spoke of the Hospital's biggest achievement during his term.

"I think the most important thing is the solidification of our professional programs, which has occured despite a complete turnover in full-time Chiefs of Staff.

"Shortly after I became Chairman, Stan Wessler resigned as Chief of Medicine. Dr. Russ Little filled in very ably as temporary Chief but then we were extremely fortunate in being able to recruit Bill Peck. Dr. Peck has provided dynamic leadership of the Department and has continued and built onto a solid base of excellence which was started under Dr. Wessler. The Department of Medicine has been able to attract large amounts of research grants.

"In Surgery, we had a similar situation with Dr. Baue leaving within a year of my becoming Chairman. Dr. Tom Covey took this position on an acting basis, after which we recruited Dr. Philpott, and while Dr. Philpott

hasn't been at the Hospital very long, I feel that he too is going to provide outstanding leadership.

"We were able to recruit Dr. Connors and Dr. Shaw into Cardiac Surgery to replace Drs. Baue and Geha and so were able to maintain open-heart surgery. I think the work we're doing in this field is outstanding and is continuing to grow in both quality and numbers of patients for whom we care.

"In Psychiatry, we were able to obtain Dr. Ted Reich, a most creative and inspiring person. I'm quite proud of the Department of Psychiatry and its accomplishments.

"We also recruited a new director of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine, Dr. Carl Pierce. He has provided a new academic dimension to the Department. Pierce is the first doctor to be appointed to the Messing Chair of Pathology and is a splendid occupant of that chair. He is well known and recognized for excellence not only at Jewish Hospital and the Medical Center, but nationwide.

"There again, we've accomplished a solidification of a department.

"In Anesthesiology, Jim Jenkins has recently been named Director, and our program under his direction has certainly prospered.

"Our new Otolaryngologist-in-Chief, Dr. Norman Druck and his associate, Dr. Laurence Levine, with the help of Dr. Joseph Ogura, have created a viable program here. We've also added to the specialists in each department, and I feel that it is not an understatement to say that The Jewish Hospital of St. Louis is operating an institution that is as good as most free-standing medical schools in the country.

"So I think that if we measure in terms of the most important thing that happened during the last five years, it is the strengthening of the professional programs."

Physical Plant Improvements Completed

"In the bricks and mortor area, the Shoenberg Pavilion was dedicated in January of 1974; we have had major remodeling in obstetrics; and are in the process of completing a new coronary care unit and new Intensive Care Unit on the 7th and 8th floors of the Shoenberg Pavilion.

"In terms of administering the Hospital, the implementation of the Technicon Medical Information System, which is currently underway, will certainly improve patient records and communication procedures."

Board Should Encourage New Programs

"Looking at the long-range future of the Hospital, I feel pretty comfortable. The Board must have dedication to see to it that whatever our professional people legitimately need they can command. No legitimate program at the Hospital should be held up because we can't find the resources for it.

"When you get people of the character of Drs. Peck, Philpott, Reich, and Pierce who provide exciting and dynamic leadership, then it's up to us to see to it that we examine their claims for resources carefully. After we complete such a review, we should see that those programs with valid claims are funded. We have the people who can lead those programs and they will make this an even more exciting place in the future."

Chairman Should Develop Ideas

"I feel that a five-year term is about right. It takes some time to learn the job, to make whatever contributions you have to make. On the other hand, if you're in the job too long, your ideas aren't fresh, you don't bring in new approaches, and I think that's the advantage of changing the leadership from time to time.

"I think it is the job of the Chairman to have different ideas. I feel very comfortable that my successor is full of ideas, and will adjust himself well in his job."

Controlling Costs Future Goal

"I feel that the Hospital is in a good position now," said Raymond H. Wittcoff, incoming Board Chairman. "We have strong professional leadership and the improvements in the physical plant put us in good shape for the future."

Wittcoff, President of Transurban Investment Corporation, is a Trustee of Washington University; a member of the Board of Directors of Washington University Medical Center, the Governmental Research Institute, and the Arts and Education Council.

According to Mr. Wittcoff, cost containment is a major issue that the Hospital must face.

"We have to maintain the highest possible standards in patient care, education and research, while at the same time controlling costs," Wittcoff said. "There's a very strong feeling in the community and in the country to do something about the inordinately high increase in medical care costs, especially in hospitals. This poses a challenge for this institution, and we've got to react to it constructively."

Primary Objective: Excellence in Health Care

"Medicine is a field where we can never

say smugly that everything is in good shape and then stand pat. There are always new discoveries in diagnosis and treatment, as well as new methods for delivering services that we have to keep abreast with.

"In our institution, we must never lose sight of the fact that our primary objective is to offer the best possible care for our patients. Our important research and educational responsibilities should help us fulfill and not divert us from that prime obligation.

"This means not only providing the best care in a technical sense, but also having an institution where people are dealt with in a warm, sensitive, understanding way."

Future of Hospital Community is Bright

An active participant in the Washington University Medical Center Redevelopment Corporation, Wittcoff said, "The redevelopment program is of great importance to the group of institutions that comprise the medical center. Some years ago, the decision was made to keep the institutions here in the city. A corollary of the decision to stay here was that we had to do something to improve the surrounding environment. That's why the hospitals and the Medical School got together and formed the Redevelopment Corporation.


"I think the Corporation is off to a good start. There are many signs of a reversal of trend. New buildings have gone up, old buildings have been rehabilitated. I think the outlook for this general area is much better than when we started a few years ago."

Describing his primary goal as Chairman, Mr. Wittcoff stressed the achievement of excellence.

"When an institution has excellence as its goal," he said, "it must be continuously striving for that goal, because it's never fully achieved."

Auxiliary Receives CPR Training

What would you do if a member of your family or a friend suffered a heart attack? Are you familiar with the basic technique of cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)? The St. Louis Heart Association says that a heart attack victim's chances of survival are greatly increased if someone nearby is trained in and can perform CPR.

Jewish Hospital Auxiliary members recently received training in CPR and how to save a choking victim by Pat Ugo, R.N., Department of Education.

"We taught them to recognize a victim who doesn't have a pulse and what to do in these circumstances," said Ms. Ugo. "For instance, if the victim is not breathing, how to properly do mouth-to-mouth resuscitation, and if they have a pulse, how to keep the victim breathing.

"It is important," she said, "to be able to

recognize a person with an impending heart attack, and what to do if the symptoms arise."

The lifesaving training was a popular program for the Auxilians who attended.


"They all thought it was a very worthwhile experience," Ms. Ugo said. "I had a lot of positive comments."

In fact, one student commented that she had used the Heimlich Maneuver (saving a choking victim) successfully on her husband. She said she had learned the technique from Ms. Ugo at a similar program a couple of years earlier.

Because of the instruction they received, there are now many Auxiliary members who are prepared to help if they witness a heart attack or choking victim.

Three New Members Named to Hospital Board





CHAIRMAN'S MESSAGE

This is my final report as Chairman of the Board of Directors of The Jewish Hospital of St. Louis. We have made tremendous progress as an institution over the last five years, and 1978 was no exception.

Early in 1978, I commissioned task forces to examine two of our most pressing problems at the Hospital. An Obstetrical Task Force, chaired by Dr. William A. Peck, Physician-in-Chief, evaluated the alternatives available to us regarding the future of Obstetrics. The Task Force concluded that Obste-

trics was essential to the professional and educational mission of the Hospital, that the program be enhanced, and that a full-time academic staff be recruited. In addition, upgrading of newborn and anesthesia services is also necessary. A Search Committee chaired by Dr. James C. Warren, Professor of Obstetrics, is presently seeking a new obstetrics department head to give full-time direction to the program.

The other study group is the Ambulatory Care Task Force chaired by Theodore Reich, M.D., Director of the Department of Psychiatry. The Task Force is examining the Outpatient Clinic, Emergency Room, private clinical practice offices and the various

referred services which annually render care to 140,000 patient visits.


The sixth floor of the Kingshighway Pavilion was renovated and used to expand the inpatient psychiatry service; the 37 bed unit was operating at nearly 100% occupancy, therefore, 13 surgical beds were converted for use by Psychiatry.

The Anesthesia Department successfully recruited five more anesthesiologists, bringing the full-time staff to ten anesthesiologists. This enlarged group together with the long time nurse anesthesia capabilities for in- and outpatient surgery, obstetrics and the pain clinic. Five additional full-time academic physicians were also successfully recruited in the Department of Medicine, bringing the complement to 30.

A search for a full-time chief of Neurology, under the direction of Dr. William Landau, was activated during the year.

During the year we celebrated the 25th anniversary of the founding of the Home Care program. This program is one of the first in the country and has served as a model for numerous hospital based home care programs.

A major step forward in medical information communications was taken during 1978 with the approval by the Greater St. Louis Health Systems Agency of the purchase and installation of a mechanized, medical information system known as the Technicon Medical Information System. The system involves communication via computer terminals between all patient care departments. It will allow immediate

exchange of information among and access thereto for Hospital staff and physicians. Vice President Irwin Albrecht, indicates it will take approximately nineteen months to completely install the system.

The Joint Commission on Accreditation of Hospitals reviewed the Hospital over a three day period in September 1978. The Commission surveyors, which include a physician, nurse and administrative reviewer, visit the Hospital every other year and conduct comprehensive evaluations of all aspects of the Hospital, including patient care standards, governance and compliance with health and safety codes.

The building program continued apace with the completion of the Cardiovascular Surgical Intensive Care Unit, a six bed specialized unit for openheart surgery program patients. Nursing Divisions 78 and 79, located on the 7th floor of the Shoenberg Pavilion, is nearing completion and should be ready for occupancy in April 1979. Each division will contain 30 beds for surgical patients. A 30 bed combined medical and telemetrically monitored unit will open in May 1979 on the west end of the 8th floor of the Shoenberg Pavilion. It will be followed by the completion of the new Medical Critical Care Center on the east end of the 8th floor of the Shoenberg Pavilion.

The renovation of the clinical laboratory areas was concluded with the major revision of the Blood Bank located on the second floor of the Kingshighway Pavilion. The Jewish Hospital Auxiliary Intermediate Surgical Intensive Care Unit was also completed at year's end.

The Miriam Lodge-United Order of True Sisters, Inc. provided a major grant for the renovation of the Rehabilitation Unit on Division 2200 for the specialized care of paraplegics and quadraplegics.

The chronic problem of parking was partially eased during the year with the purchase of parcel of land two blocks east of the Hospital. Plans are to develop this parking for approximately 400 employees thus freeing the garage for use by patients, visitors, physicians and other short-term parkers. In the interim, employee parking is being provided in Forest Park with shuttle bus system transporting employees to and from the Hospital.

The Hospital continued its support of the New Americans program by providing medical services to approximately 150 Soviet Jewish immigrant families this year. The Hospital's team of translators, social workers, and health care professionals deal with the specialized medical and social adjustment needs of these new St. Louis residents. The Jewish Federation of St. Louis assisted in the support of this program as well as with the medical education and research activities of the Hospital through a grant of \$250,000.

The Auxiliary, under the leadership of Helene Goldstein, extended its previously outstanding record. The Auxiliary's Health Fair, chaired by Barbara Schukar, was held in October at Clayton High School and provided a broad range of health information for members of the community. It effectively involved the patient care capabilities of the Hospital as well as other health agencies.

Richard Meyerhardt continued as the President of the Associates of the Jewish Hospital. In addition to the fine medical information programs presented by the Associates, they provided funds for the establishment of a patient education TV system. This allows the Hospital's Department of Education to utilize the in-house patient TV system for education programs for our patients.

In January of 1978, the School of Nursing graduated eighty-four students. The school provides superbly trained nurses for the staffing of our Hospital as well as for other health care institutions in the St. Louis community.

One of the major activities of an academic teaching hospital is the conduct of medical research. The Jewish Hospital of St. Louis is one of less than 1% of the nation's 7,000 hospitals that are heavily engaged in research activities. During 1978, the research program had a budget of \$3.5 million; financial support for these programs comes from a variety of federal and private foundation grants, as well as individual philanthropy.

I take great pride in having had the privilege of serving as Chairman of the Board of The Jewish Hospital of St. Louis and wish Mr. Raymond H. Wittcoff success as he assumes the Chairmanship.

"What happens to my Tribute Fund donation after I send it in?"

This is a question that many Tribute Fund donors may be wondering. Donors can see their names listed in the 216 under the memorialized or honored person they choose, but where does the money actually go?

Why it Began

Mrs. Henry Stern and Mrs. Clarence Eckert became the first Tribute Fund chairmen in 1952. It was started by the Jewish Hospital Auxiliary in order to attract donations for medical research and pay for the special medical needs of patients who could not afford them.

The original plan of memorializing or honoring the tributee in the **216** has not changed over the years. The beneficiaries of the fund also remain the same. The only real difference is in the amazing growth of the Tribute Fund donors.

Named Funds Benefit Specific Needs

Unspecified donations go into the general fund, an account which pays for medical supplies such as dentures and glasses. Russian immigrants coming into the United States under the New Americans Program are a good example of people whom this fund helps.

Over 180 named funds also make up the Tribute Fund. These funds are each set up to benefit a particular medical need.


How Does a Fund Get Started?

About eight to 10 new funds are established every year. In order to start a named fund, the donor must give or pledge an initial contribution of \$500. The specific area of medicine that the proceeds of the fund go to are up to the discretion of the donor.

The Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology has a number of such funds: the Dr. Sol Weisman Fund; the Dr. Samuel D. Soule

Fund; the Dr. Leon Foster Fund; and Dr. Burstein's Ob-Gyn Fund.

"Doctors Weisman and Foster were two obstetricians on our staff that were very popular physicians at the time," said Robert Burstein, M.D., Director of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology. "When they died, money was sent into the Hospital Tribute Fund in memory of them.

"The Foster Fund money is used for an annual Leon Foster Lectureship," Burstein said.

Most of the other Ob-Gyn funds are used to pay for laboratory equipment. Dr. Burstein's fund is a good example.

"It allows me to buy research supplies," he said, "or any equipment that we cannot get the funds for elsewhere."

Tribute Fund Aids Cancer Research

Among the many ongoing research activities at Jewish Hospital is the area of cancer research. Doctors Ralph Graff and Cary Presant are two of the Hospital's researchers who are aided in their studies by the Tribute Fund.

"One of our ultimate goals is to analyze the relationship between the patient and his or her cancer, and then develop an approach for that specific patient," said Ralph Graff, M.D.


With the help of Dr. Graff's Research Fund, immunotherapy is currently under study as a cancer treatment.

"To develop immunotherapy," said Dr. Graff, "we treat patients in a way to strengthen their own defenses against cancer.

"We have been studying how the immune system reacts to cancer in experimental animals and people," he said. "We also study ways the immune system can be altered to help defend against cancer."

Developing a Treatment Program

"Cancer cells can spread and invade other



Cary Presant, M.D.




Cary Presant, M.D., examines a gel electrophoresis.

organs," said Cary Presant, M.D., Assistant Professor of Medicine, Hematology/ Oncology. "Treatments are being developed which are designed to decrease this tendency of cancer cells to spread throughout the body."

Dr. Presant's cancer research is aided by the Cancer Progress Fund. Experiments are performed in his laboratory to determine how to change the surface of the cancer cell.

"We're testing new drugs which can alter the surface of cells and thereby modify cancer growth. We have tested mice that have tumors, and so far we can prolong their lives by treating their cancers with these drugs. Ultimately, we intend that this treatment could be safely used in our patients to help improve their symptoms, help them live longer, and perhaps even cure their widespread tumors.

"The Cancer Progress Fund has been helpful in starting these experiments and also in



evaluating trials of many different types of experimental treatment. New treatments for leukemia, breast cancer, lung cancer, colon cancer and melanoma have resulted in part from the generous contributions made to the Cancer Progress Fund."

Funds for Pacemakers Provided

In addition to research activities, several named funds provide medical items of special need. One such fund is the William, Dorothy and Jerome Molasky Fund, which supports cardiac patient care and the purchase of cardiac equipment.

Like many medical appliances, the pacemaker has been improved greatly since its inception. Through research and technology, the devices have seen great improvements in the last few years.

"They've become more versatile," said

Richard Shaw, M.D., Division of Cardiothoracic Surgery. "Changes have been made in the power source. Batteries previously lasted a year or two, but now can last as long as 10 years or more.

"The batteries are smaller now, so they are tolerated better by patients," Shaw said. "The connectons that go to the heart have been improved and maintain more stable function."


Many Areas Supported by Funds

Each named Tribute Fund supports its own individual medical field. Blood research, kidney, psychiatry, liver, surgery and otolaryngology research are all aided by specific funds.
